


EARLY SETTLERS WOULD TRAVEL CROSS COUNTRY WITH ALL




ROUND ROCK WAS ONCE NAMED BRUSHY IN HONOR OF BRUSHY CREEK. THEY ESTABLISHED A POST OFFICE IN 1851. HOWEVER, THE POSTAL AUTHORITIES INFORMED THE POSTMASTER IN 1854 THAT THE NAME WAS ALREADY IN USE AND SO THE POSTMASTER DECIDED TO NAME THE SETTLEMENT ROUND ROCK TO HONOR HIS FAVORITE FISHING SPOT.
